Southside Road Reconstruction

Extensive work was completed on the Southside Road Capital Project including replacing damaged culverts, reclaiming, paving, and shoulder work.



New Excavator

DPW received delivery of a new Link-Belt model 75X3 backhoe/excavator complete with four specific-use attachments including a 48" ditching bucket, a 30" digging bucket, a hydraulic hammer and ripper tooth.



Road Paving

From Deer Run to Saltwater Drive and Southside Road to Chases Pond Road, exceptional weather allowed DPW to complete over a dozen road paving projects throughout the town for over 11,000 feet of smooth, newly paved roads.

New Truck

DPW received delivery of a new International Class 8 truck frame and chassis. This heavy-duty, six-wheel steel frame and chassis was custom-built for DPW and will be fitted out with features to meet the needs of year-round use.
