DPW took delivery of a new Broom Badger from Elgin Sweeper. This maneuverable, powerful and efficient mechanical sweeper has best-in-class features and consumes less fuel when operating.

FEMA DECLARATION

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) included York in the Federal Disaster Declarations for reimbursement and funds to help repair damaged infrastructure from the severe storms that hit in January. Declarations include DR 4696 (Elliot – Dec 2022), DR 4764 (Heather – Jan 2024) and DR 4785 (Tormund – April 2024).

PARKING KIOSKS

DPW installed the remaining operating parking kiosks at the beaches while helping to educate and inform residents and visitors of a new contactless paid parking phone app from ParkMobile. The easy-to-use app eliminates the need to “feed the meter” by giving users the convenience of paying for parking using their phone.

Street paving got well underway this quarter with complete resurfacing of Angel Avenue, Avon Avenue, Camden Avenue, Fernald Avenue and Meadowlark while new shim surface was laid on Bluestone, Pine Hill South and Old Seabury.
